Once upon a time... well, ok, maybe not that long ago, 6 years to be more precise, the lecture hall of the Nagy Oktatas Building, Dom Ter 12, Szeged, was filled with a 'helluva' lot of first year students. Freshmen – or fresh meat for the SZOTE grinder as the seniors would joke – gathered, mingled and began to forge acquaintances, hopefully to turn into friendships. Thrown headfirst into first year hell – Biology – we were gleefully told by various professors how hard it was going to be to make it through medical school here. Actually, one even said, "you shall come to the exam and I shall fail you!" Yes... 'twas a promising start to our 6-year roller coaster ride courtesy of SZOTE!

First year turned out to be a rush of MTO's, exams and classes that we apparently HAD to attend. Yeah right! They scared us, failed us, made fun of us, but they couldn't break us. They gave us a rulebook and we chucked it out the window. Instead, we attended some lectures, a few more practicals and lots of parties. Hey, we were in med school after all – how else were we supposed to live up to the crazy med students' reputation? First semester exams threatened to put a hitch in our stride, but we forged on nonetheless, proudly bearing our battle scars. One semester down... how many more to go? 11?! Oh well, baby steps now, perchance someday to run!

The difficulty level had gone up a notch, for there seemed to be a never ending stream of MTO's and repeats to get through. So to strike a good balance we also partied

harder! Then came the exams... the dreaded Anatomy final: two years worth of information, names of every last structure in the body, some of which were bigger than the structure itself! Third year was our make-or-break year, our potential Achilles' heel. This year cranked the difficulty level all the way up. "Ting" went the bell and the fight was on... Us versus the Pathology/Pathophysiology tag-team. We also had Microbiology to contend with, but it was a walk in the park compared to the other two. Pathology was in effect, Anatomy gone wrong and Pathophysiology explained the how and the why. Who can forget Pathology and Prof. Ivany's many many "blah-omas". Or the time he didn't switch off his microphone during the lecture break and we could hear him talking in the bowels of the Pathology department and then suddenly a rush of water! This year was the year that they unleashed us on patients... real, live patients... for the first time. Internal medicine clinicals were introduced, along with Medical Hungarian. Joy! We also had Surgical Techniques, which was thrilling for some, distressing for others, and the rest didn't really care. It put people in knots – quite literally!

Third year churned out a spate of MTOs and repeat MTOs. Seemed like everytime we blinked, we had another MTO looming on the horizon. Desperate for release, we crammed Fun into every nook and cranny. We had a fantastic Halloween Party – Anat and Roby as Dexter and Dee Dee, Sexy Tarjei, Slutty Doogie, Kanwal the perfect Indian wife, Eirill and Itai as the Two Stupid Dogs. We also had a whole bunch of our boys in drag, a fairy, a gypsy, a bumblebee and more. And to cap off the year... the dreaded finals... the bottleneck of SZOTE. Would we make it or






